Wisconsin Shorthorn Lassie Program Description

Application due February 1

Applications must be postmarked or electronically received on or before February 1.

Lassie and Queen applicants must apply each year.

Interviews may be conducted for Princess and Queen applicants.

Qualifications to Apply

Lassie Princess

Must be 15 years old by January 1 to apply

Must serve for 1 year as WSA Lassie Princess in order to apply for WSA Lassie Queen

May repeatedly apply to be WSA Lassie Princess until the age of 21

There may be more than one Lassie Princess in any given year

Lassie Queen

There will only be one Lassie Queen in any given year

Can serve as the WSA Lassie Queen 2 times

Must be 16-21 years old by January 1 to apply for National Lassie Queen

Can apply to be National Lassie Queen twice

Must be nominated by the WSA to apply for National Lassie Queen

The current year's WSA Lassie Queen is given first priority when applying for National Lassie Queen

Lassie Queen costume must be worn at required events listed below

Official Duties

Promote and represent the Shorthorn breed and the Wisconsin Shorthorn Assoc.

Answer questions about the Shorthorn breed and the Wisconsin Shorthorn Assoc.

Hand out ribbons and provide assistance at shows

Have picture taken with the breed winners at shows
